need to offer recyclability and recycled content. Inhaus' new proprietary technology for rigid core flooring offers both. When done right, it's a circular journey for the material. As an example, with Inhaus, yesterday's yogurt cup is today's Inhaus flooring and tomorrow's piece of lawn furniture.

Inhaus' new German-based proprietary rigid core flooring technology was invented to create the most durable, beautiful, and functional flooring in the industry and to be manufactured in a sustainable way. At the heart of the



concept is the use of polypropylene or PP, which is one of the two most commonly used plastics in the world and is revered for its safe-for-consumer properties, durability, and recyclability.

As a result, Inhaus' rigid core flooring



is 100% recyclable (including the attached pad which is also PP) and also utilizes 25% post-consumer PP recycled content. This is a winning combination on a variety of levels as the PP construction offers unsurpassed durability and sustainability.

Further, the core construction only utilizes PP and mineral filler, nothing else. There are no extra plasticizers, formaldehyde, PVC, or additives. The result is not only a recyclable product that uses recycled content but also one that is leading in low VOC emissions.

With the use of this technology, Inhaus Sono Eclipse product line is highly durable and designed to withstand the



demands of the busiest of households while promoting a healthy indoor air environment. Inhaus' rigid core flooring is dimensionally stable against changing temperatures and completely waterproof – making it safe to install in three-season rooms. It features Inhaus' Megaloc (angle fold) locking system, which enables Sono Eclipse to be installed in spaces up to 100'x100' without transitions and includes an acoustical attached pad that can also be glued down.



Product visuals are made with state-of-the-art, high-definition digital printers using UV-resistant ink, guaranteeing that the design will not fade from sun exposure. Each style features 18 unique planks (16 tile) or 51 sq ft of unique décor material, which enables homeowners to cover larger areas with a minimal number of repeats – enhancing authenticity. Sono Eclipse's surface is produced with a PP film for dent and chip resistance and then finished with an industrial acrylic lacquer that is digitally applied in a process known as Digital Lacquer Embossing (DLE).

The DLE process creates an embossed-in-register surface as standard on all Sono Eclipse offerings.

The final lacquer layer is applied using an excimer process which cures the lacquer with ultraviolet (UV) light in an oxygen-free environment. The result is an ultra-authentic, highly durable matte finish that is soft to the touch, similar to real wood, and is anti-footprint. In addition to featuring an ultra-matte and highly durable finish, the completed



surface is also stain and scratch-resistant. It can be easily cleaned or disinfected and is approved for steam mops.
