There are two branches that are the foundation of CHE's Consumer Advocacy discipline: their Contractor Checklist and their tried-and-true 10-step remodeling process. Because of this two-pronged approach, CHE raises the bar on performance standards in the home improvement industry by averaging a 30 percent growth in annual revenue, sustaining a 99.25 percent customer service rating, and completing more than 400 projects a year.

"I'm a proponent of a disciplined process. Both the quality and communication will be improved if the customer knows the steps, and we consistently communicate that throughout the production process," says Cligrow.

Frankie Cimino, a past client, is helping to grow their business – and appreciated the team's stellar communication. CHE installed a porch enclosure in the back of his home and he says he's landed them four more jobs, including one for his son, in the past year.

"It's all about doing the right thing by people and it pays off," he says. "I'm in the construction business, and they're a very good business. The people that worked here were excellent. If you had a question, they would explain everything. ... And if you needed to reach them, they'd call you back. They do what they say they are going to do."

- Contractor and business licenses, which proves they are qualified and certified.
- Credit check and lien

- **history**, which shows their business integrity and financial stability.
- Certificate and proof of insurance, showing their safety and liability.
- Adheres to local, county, and state code and building regulations, showing they are ethical and legal.
- Material and labor warranties, proving their quality workmanship and

- company guarantee.
- Formal written contract, proof of their legal and company accountability.
- Customer testimonials and project portfolio, which proves their reputation and reliability.
- Company's investment in a showroom, warehouse, and truck fleet, showing their commitment and resources.
- Bank supplier and reference **letters,** which shows their financial stability and authorized dealership.
- Professional affiliations and BBB accreditation, proving their industry knowledge and dependability.
- Chamber of Commerce **membership**, a proof of their reputation and community involvement.

The checklist all culminates with the company's mission: to deliver quality products on time with excellent service before, during, and after the sale, respecting their customer's time, property, and their need to be in the communication process.

"With our Google, Facebook and

BBB reviews." says Cligrow, "we receive an overwhelming

majority of positive feedback, so that is proof and evidence that we are fulfilling our mission as a successful business, especially in a world that is very critical of the construction industry. This is the result of what our effective business process is, rooted in employee education and customer communication."

The 10-step process that CHE uses, which is, again, based on transparent communication with the customer for a remodel, design or installation, has also been a critical key to their success. It all starts with an initial complimentary consultation, continues with measuring, engineering, and permitting, and finishes with a final walkthrough.

Homeowners can also get an estimate online by using CHE's innovative "Instant Pricer," a custom-designed, user-friendly tool that allows the customer to build their own room online and receive an estimate instantly via email.

"Probably the number one question always asked is, 'How much does it cost?' And, with everything so customized, it's very hard to estimate because we don't have a standard square foot cost," says Cligrow. "But, with this tool, you can go online, pick out from the ground up your floor plan, type of wall system, roof system,

window system. and that will give you a good ballpark of what price range you would be in. That starts the general information of giving estimates based on size. style, and roof design."

"We were very impressed with the way that you can customize your own design," says Kathy Durante, who worked with CHE to customdesign a pool enclosure. "With the color, a lot of the lanais are white, and being in the South with the pollen and everything, I didn't want a white one, so they offered a
